How to use the pattern –

I would print off two sets off the pattern.

With the first pattern, tape together all pattern pieces. Refer to North American map for placement. Line up all the pattern pieces with the numbers situated in the lower left hand corner.

Once that is taped together, then you can take the second pattern and begin to cut out your individual provinces and territories. You may want to color the provinces and territories different colors to keep them together. I used washi tape to put together the pieces so that I could move pieces around easier.

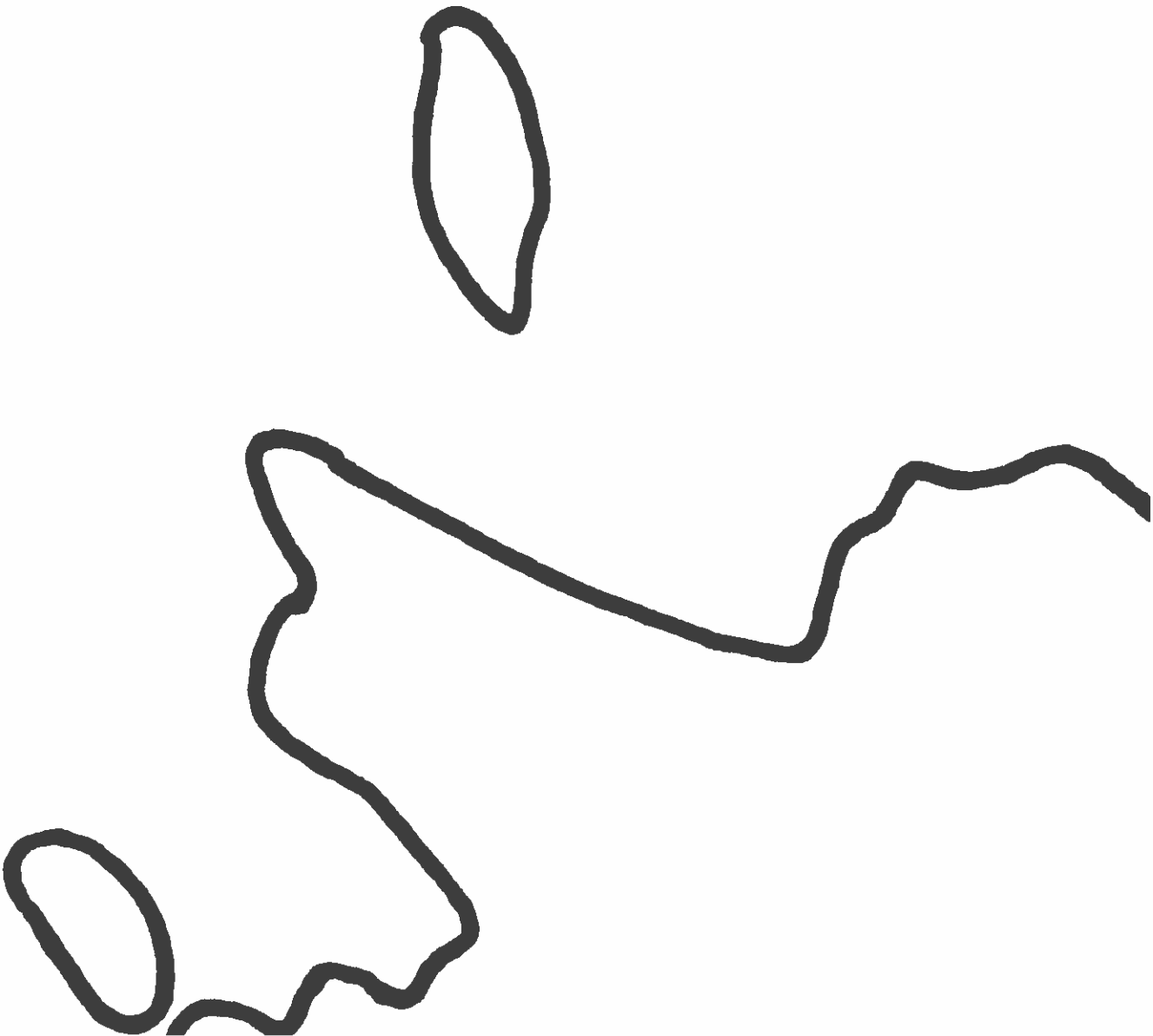
When combining the Canadian map and the United States map, pay particular attention to Michigan. It will not fill up the whole area because there are two lakes surrounding the bottom portion of the state. It does sit above Illinois and Ohio – so try to line it up with those states. (Use Google maps to help!)

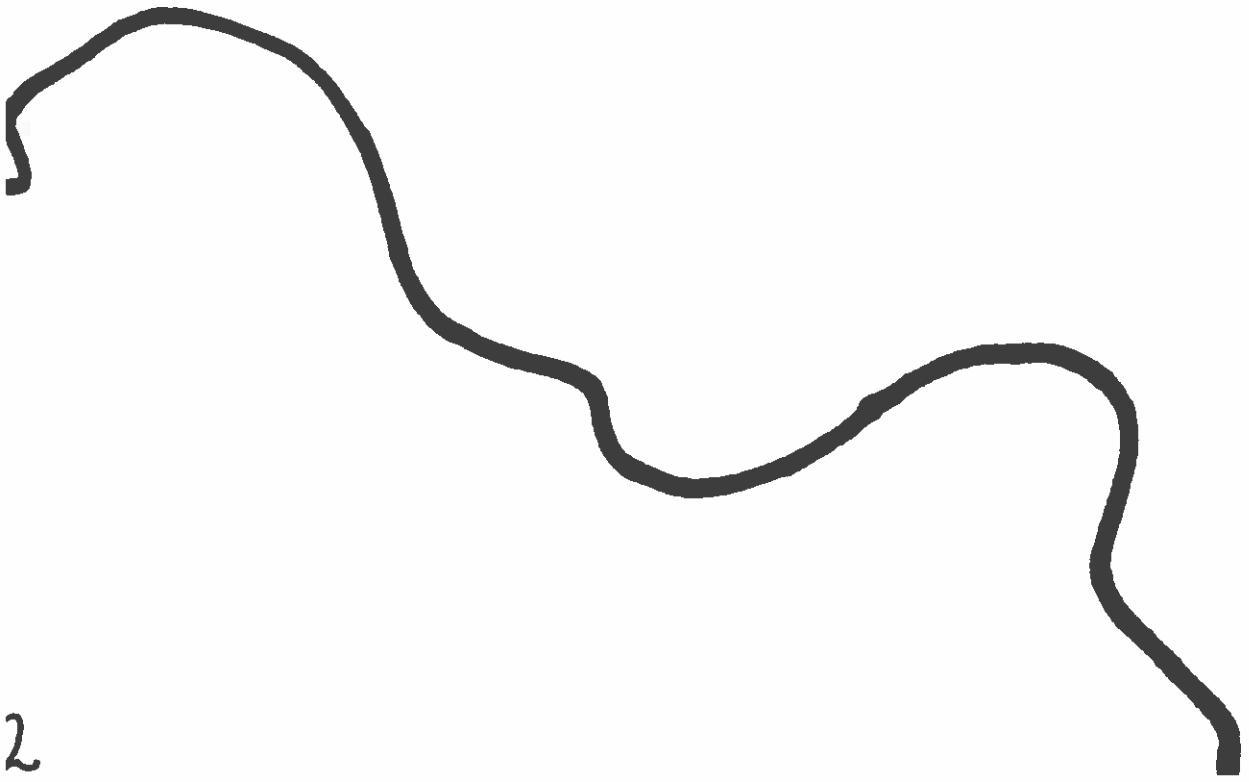
