



	U-V	10" x 10" Farmhouse Christmas Trees Black
Border Print	W	1/8 yard Farmhouse Christmas Snowflakes Black
Backing		1 1/4 yard
Batting		21" x 47" piece
Binding	_	5/8 yard Farmhouse Christmas Plaid Red



All seam allowances are 1/4" WOF - Width of Fabric HST - Half Square Triangle

## Center Quilt Block - Make 1



Make 1 - Unfinished Quilt Block - 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"

## Cutting:

Prints	O - 1 - 2" x 3" piece P - 1 - 2" x 5" piece Q - 1 - 2" x 6 1/2" piece K - 1 - 2" x 2" square L - 1 - 2" x 2" square S - 1 - 3" x 12 1/2" square T - 2 - 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" pieces U - 2 - 1 1/2" x 9 1/2 Pieces
Background	A - 6 - 2" x 2" squares B - 2 - 2" x 2 3/4" pieces C - 2 - 2" x 1 3/4" pieces D - 2 - 2" x 1" pieces E - 2 - 2" x 3 1/4" pieces F - 2 - 2" x 8 1/2" pieces G - 2 - 3" x 3" squares H - 1 - 2" x 7" piece I - 1 - 2" x 4 1/2" piece

## Assembly:

#### Step 1:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the A background pieces. Place an A piece on the left side of a Q print piece, aligned as shown. Sew on the marked line, trim 1/4" away from the seam, and press.



Repeat for the right side, sewing an A background piece to the right side of the Q piece, aligned as shown.



Sew a D background piece on the left and right sides of the Q piece.



#### Step 2:

Repeat Step 1 for pieces O and P, sewing an A background piece on the left and right sides.

Sew a C background piece on the left and right sides of the P piece and a B background piece on the left and right sides of the O piece.




#### Step 3:

Sew an E background piece on the left and right sides of the L print piece.  $\leftarrow$   $\rightarrow$ 


#### Step 4:

Sew the four sections together to make a tree unit. The unit should measure 6 1/2" x 7 1/2" unfinished.




#### Step 5:

Sew a T print piece on the left and right sides of the tree unit.




Sew a U print piece to the top and bottom sides of the tree unit.



#### Step 6:

Sew an F background piece on the left and right sides of the tree unit.



#### Step 7:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the G background squares. Sew one on the left and right sides of the S print piece, as you did in Step 1. The G pieces should be aligned as shown. This is the roof unit.




#### Step 8:

Sew an H background piece on the left side of the K print piece and an I background piece on the right side of the K print piece. This is the chimney unit.


#### Step 9:

Sew the roof and chimney units above the tree unit as shown.

## Center Quilt Block Assembly cont:



### Side Quilt Blocks - Make 2



Make 2 - Unfinished Quilt Block - 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"

### Cutting:

Prints	M - 4 - 4" x 4" squares N - 8 - 4" x 4" squares R - 24 - 2" x 2" squares T - 4 - 4" x 4" squares
Background	J - 16 - 4" x 4" squares

## Assembly:

Half Square Triangle Instructions:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a background square. Place the background square right sides together with a print square. Sew a 1/4" seam on both sides of the marked line. Cut down the marked line. Press the seams to the darker fabric. Trim the HST to  $3\ 1/2$ " square.













Place two M print squares right sides together with two J background squares. Make HST's as shown above. Make two for a total of four HST's.









#### Step 2:

Place four N print squares right sides together with four J background squares. Make HST's as shown above. Make four for a total of eight HST's

















Step 3:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of eight R print pieces. Place the print square on the background side of the NJ HST's, aligned as shown. Sew on the marked line, trim 1/4" away from the seam, and press. Repeat for all eight NJ units.















Step 4:

Repeat Steps 2 and 3 with T print squares and J background squares. Add eight R print squares to the corners of the background squares.

















Step 5: Assemble the side block as shown.






## Borders and Finishing

### Cutting:


Background Borders	AA - 2 - 1 3/4" x 12 1/2" pieces BB - 2 - 1 3/4" x 39" pieces CC - 6 - 1 1/2" x 2" pieces DD - 4 - 1 1/2" x 1 5/8" pieces EE - 14 - 1 1/2" x 2 1/4" pieces FF - 2 - 1 3/4" x 17" pieces GG - 2 - 1 3/4" x 43 1/2" pieces
Print Border	W - 24 - 1 1/2 " x 3 1/2" pieces
Batting	1 piece 21 " x 47"
Backing	2 pieces 21 " x 24"
Binding	4 strips 2 1/2" x WOF

## Borders and Finishing Cont:

Sew the three block units together, with the house unit in the center.




Sew the inner border pieces in place, sewing the side borders on first and then the top and bottom borders.




Sew the side pieced border units together as shown. Make 2.


Sew the top and bottom pieced border units together as shown. Make 2.




Sew the top and bottom pieced border units to the top and bottom of the runner.



Sew the side pieced border units to the left and right sides of the runner.



Sew the outer border pieces to the runner, sewing the side borders on first and then the top and bottom border pieces.



Layer together the runner top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired.

Sew together binding strips, end to end. Bind as desired.
