
Finished Pillow Size: 20" x 20"

Fabric Requirements	
Background	1/3 yard - Riley White Solid
Block Prints	1 - 5" stacker - Stardust fabric - 10 - 5" x 5" pieces from the stacker will be used
Border Print	1/4 yard - Ballerina Stardust Main
Backing	3/4 yard
Batting	21" x 21" piece
Pillow Form	20" x 20"



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Quilt Block



Make 1 - Unfinished Quilt Block - 14 1/2" x 14 1/2"

Cutting:

Background	A - 4 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares B - 4 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares C - 4 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares D - 4 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles E - 2 - 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles
Prints	F - 2 - 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" rectangles G - 1 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" square H - 8 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares
	I - 8 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares J - 4 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares K - 4 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares Cut K fabrics from two prints

Assembly:

Sten 1

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the H print pieces. Place one H print piece right sides together with the A background piece, on the lower left corner, with the diagonal line aligned as shown. Sew on the marked line, trim 1/4" away from the seam and press the seam towards the print fabric. Make 4. Repeat with another H print piece on the lower right corner of the A background pieces. Repeat with all four pieces.





Step 2

Repeat Step 1, sewing I print pieces to the top corners of the ${\bf A}$ background pieces. Make four.



Step 3:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $\bf B$ background pieces. Place these right sides together with the $\bf J$ print squares. Sew on the marked line, trim 1/4" away from the seam and press the seam towards the print fabric. Make 4 HST's.










Abbreviations: HST - Half Square Triangle

All seam allowances are 1/4"


Step 4:

Sew a $\bf C$ background piece on the bottom side of an HST piece. Press towards the sashing piece. Sew a $\bf D$ background piece to the side of the HST unit as shown. Press towards the sashing piece.

Make 4 units, aligning the pieces as shown.




Step 5: Assemble center of quilt block as follows.




Step 6:

Sew an **E** background piece on the left and right sides of the block. Sew an **F** background piece on the top and bottom sides of the block.



Step 7:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the K print pieces. Sew one to each corner, with the diagonal lines aligned as shown. Place the prints that match on opposite corners. Sew on the marked line, trim 1/4" away from the seam and press.




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Assembly:

Borders	A - 2 - 3 1/2" x 14 1/2" B - 2 - 3 1/2" x 20 1/2"
Backing	1 piece 20 1/2" x 20 1/2"

Sew the A border strips on the left and right sides of the block Sew the B border strips on the top and bottom of the block



Finishing:

Layer the top with a 20 1/2" x 20 1/2" piece of batting and quilt the pillow front if desired.

Place the pillow front and backing right sides together and sew around most of all four sides, leaving an opening on the bottom seam of at least 12". Clip corners, turn pillow cover right sides out and press. Place a pillow form inside the cover and hand sew the opening closed.
