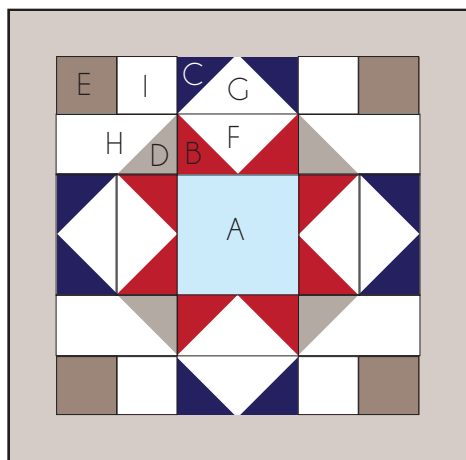


Watercolor Barn Mini Quilt



19" x 19" Mini Quilt

Materials:

A - Center Square - 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" (I used the EQ Printable fabric sheets for my center square)

Print fabrics:

B - 8 pieces - 3" x 3"

C - 8 pieces - 3" x 3"

D - 4 pieces - 3" x 3"

E - 4 pieces - 3" x 3"

Background fabric:

F - 4 pieces - 3" x 5 1/2"

G - 4 pieces - 3" x 5 1/2"

H - 4 pieces - 3" x 5 1/2"

I - 4 pieces - 3" x 3"

Border fabric:

Cut 2 pieces 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" and 2 pieces 2 1/2" x 19 1/2"

Instructions:

1. Draw a diagonal line of the wrong side of the B, C, and D print pieces. Place a B piece on the left side of a F background piece, with the line aligned as shown. Sew on the marked line, then trim 1/4" away from the line. Press towards the darker fabric. Repeat with another B print piece on the right side of the F background piece, with the line aligned as shown. Sew on the marked line, then trim 1/4" away from the seam. Make a total of four units.



2. Repeat with the C and G pieces. Make a total of four units.



3. Place a D print piece right sides together on the right side of an H background square, with the line aligned as shown. Sew on the marked line and trim. Make two.

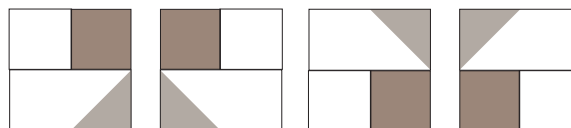
Make two D/H units with the print square on the left side of the H background square.



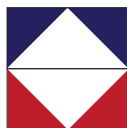
4. Sew a I background square to one side of an E print square.



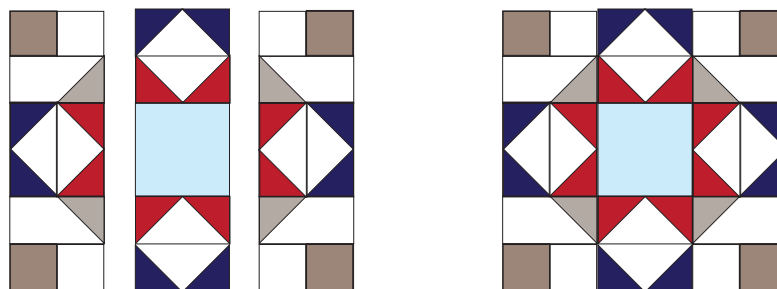
5. Sew the E/I units to the H/D units. Make four, with the units aligned as shown.



6. Sew the B/F units to the C/G units, aligned as shown. Make four.



7. Assemble the center block as shown.



8. Sew the 15 1/2" pieces to the left and right sides of the block. Sew the 19 1/2" border pieces to the top and bottom of the block.

9. Quilt as desired. Trim to 19" x 19" and bind.
