

Liberty Flag Pillow

All seam allowances are 1/4"

Pillow Size - 12" x 20"

Fabric Requirements:

Pillow Front Fabric:

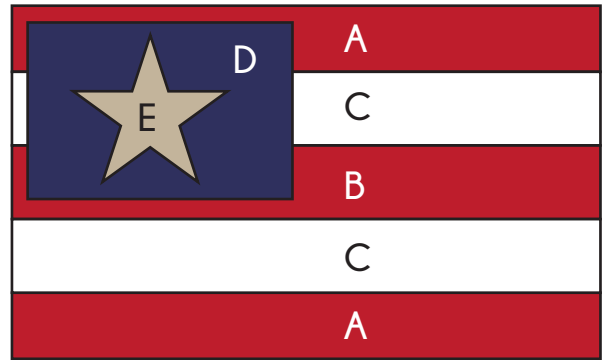
- 2 different red print fabrics - 2 1/4" x 20 1/2" of each
- 1 red print fabric - 2 1/2" x 20 1/2"
- 2 different white print fabrics - 2 1/2" x 20 1/2" of each
- 1 navy print fabric - 6" x 9"
- 1 tan or linen solid fabric - 6" x 6"

Pillow Back fabric:

- 1 piece 12 1/2" x 20 1/2"

You will also need:

- 1 piece of batting - 14" x 22"
- 1 piece of lining fabric - 14" x 22"
- 1 pillow form - 12" x 20"
- Optional pom pom trim: 2 yards
- Contrasting Navy Embroidery Floss



Step 4:

If you are adding the embroidery running stitch details, stitch inside the star on the tan solid, 1/4" inside the star. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the seams on the striped pieces.

Step 5:

Layer together the pillow top, the batting, and the lining fabric. Quilt the pillow top as desired. Trim the batting and lining to 12 1/2" x 20 1/2".

Step 6:

If you are adding pom pom trim, sew that around all four sides of the pillow top, overlapping the trim ends at the bottom center of the front. Sew the trim on so the pom poms point in towards the center of the pillow.

Step 7:

Place the pillow front and back right sides together. Sew around the four sides and leave an opening 10" in the bottom center seam. Take care not to catch any of the pom poms. Clip the corners of the pillow at an angle without cutting the seam and turn right side out through the opening. Use a turning tool to poke the corners of the pillow into nice sharp corners. Press.

Step 8:

Place the pillow form in the pillow and hand sew the opening closed.

Cutting:

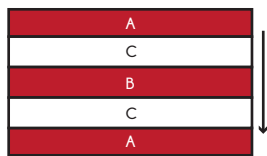
Pillow Front:

- A - From two different red fabrics, cut 1 piece 2 1/4" x 20 1/2" (for a total of two pieces)
- B - From remaining red print fabric, cut 1 piece 2 1/2" x 20 1/2"
- C - From two different white fabrics, cut 1 piece 2 1/2" x 20 1/2" (for a total of two pieces)
- D - From Navy Print, cut 1 piece 6" x 9"
- E - From Tan Solid, cut one piece 5 1/2" x 5 1/2"

Pillow Top Assembly:

Step 1:

Sew the A, B, and C strips together in the order shown, with an A piece on the top and bottom sides.



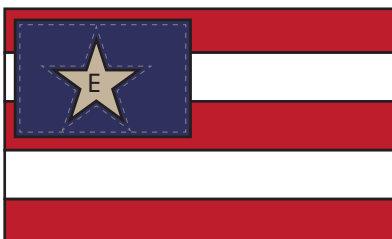
Step 2:

Measure the center of the D print piece. Using the Star pattern, cut out a star shape.



Step 3:

Measure from the top left corner down 3/4" from top and left sides of the A/B/C unit and place the D piece. Pin the left side of the D piece. Tuck the E piece under the D piece and center it under the star cut out, so none of the A/B/C unit shows through the star. Pin in place well. Sew down the D and E pieces, 1/4" around the star opening and inside the D edge. This will leave raw edges that will look scrappy and fun.
